### Burn and wound

Our Gene and Barbara Burnett Burn Center is the only burn center in the region accredited for adult and pediatric care by the American Burn Association and the American College of Surgeons. We provide individualized care, comfort and recovery for complex burns and wounds, including hyperbaric oxygen therapy, wellness programs and survivor groups.

### Cancer

The University of Kansas Cancer Center is among only 71 National Cancer Institute-designated cancer centers in the nation. Our experts treat breast, lung, prostate, colon, sarcoma, head and neck, and blood and marrow cancers. We offer:

- Access to clinical trials and leading treatment
- The region's largest blood and marrow transplant program
